A Note From The Board President

A new rule has recently been established and approved by the Board of Directors and will be added as line D of Section II of the Clubhouse Usage Guidelines in the Summerlakes Handbook.

The rule is effective immediately and is as follows:

D) All cameras, cell phones with camera/video capabilities, lpads with camera/video capabilities, and other mobile devices with camera/recording capabilities, including voice recording, are prohibited in the bathrooms, locker rooms, showers, or any other private area. Cell phone usage in locker rooms is prohibited as a common courtesy to all guests.

Also, please note the addition to line C of Section II of Clubhouse Usage Guidelines, which covers inappropriate behavior in the clubhouse. This behavior includes inappropriate language, name calling of staff, residents or their guests; refutable to obeying staff, and rudeness to staff. Such behavior will not be tolerated.



SUMMERLAKES HOMEOWNERS' BOARD MEETING

JUNE 9, 2022

Meeting was called to order by President Steve Lewis at 7:02 pm.

Board Members Present: Steven Lewis, Harlan Davis, Fred Baker, Megan Kleiber.

Homeowner Comments: None

<u>Board Members Comments</u>: Summer cost for clubhouse usage in summer is \$5.00 for those 11 or older as stated in Clubhouse Usage Guidelines.

<u>Secretary Report</u>: May minutes were submitted for approval. Megan Kleiber moved to approve and seconded by Fred Baker. May minutes were accepted.

<u>Financial Report</u>: May P/L statement was presented, and motion to accept was made by Harlan Davis, and Seconded by Megan Kleiber. P/L was accepted.

Old Business:

Computer: New desktop, server was purchased and installed. System is up and functioning.

<u>Pool</u>: Pool was opened on time. Area available inside of current pool fencing is 70 by 120. Replacement pool could be 30 (5 feet narrower) and 90 feet in length (10 feet longer)

Continental Pond: The pond was treated for algae.

<u>Playground</u>: There is a binder at clubhouse with plan for 3 play sets at Cynthia park, and 3 play sets at Continental Park.

Picnic: Menu for food trucks needs to be supplied to Micki so that it can published in July newsletter.

<u>Clubhouse Rule Change</u>: The rule change for prohibiting usage of cameras, ipads, or any device to take images in locker rooms and bathrooms. Violation would result in suspension of access to Clubhouse Building. The rule change was approved by Board. The new rule will be added as section D of General Policy of Clubhouse Usage Guildelines. A mailing of the 4 pages of Clubhouse Usage Guidelines will be mailed to all residents. The mailing will include the cover letter indicating addition, and noting Section C of aforementioned include verbal abuse of staff, usage of inappropriate language, or refusal to obey staff.

<u>Delinquent Accounts</u>: The next step for collection of delinquent accounts is eviction. The Board would like further explanation from our Attorney before processing.

<u>Bank Stablization</u>: The wet weather prevented planting of edge water planting. City is requiring planting to close permit.

Adjournment: At 7:43, Fred Baker made a motion for Adjournment. Motion was seconded by Megan, and approved by Board.
