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We Cannot Have Nice Things if There is Continued Vandilism

Recently we have had some very disappointing incidents at both Cynthia and Continental Parks. We've refurbished and improved both of these playgrounds, and would very much like to add more amenities to them but, as everyone knows sometimes things we want to do has to wait until more money is available. Our annual budget allows for maintaining our community property and some amount of accidental breakage and needed replacements are included in this as well. Unfortunately some people have decided to damage or steal some of this new equipment.

A soccer goal at Continental Park has been broken. The damage, broken supports, was extensive and left the goal not just unusable but dangerous (sharp ends on poles that could cut or stab). This damage could only have been caused by deliberate misuse. These soccer goals are just that, goals, not chin up bars, not for swinging on but targets for kicking soccer balls into.

It is even more disappointing that we have had swings deliberately damaged or just plain stolen. This has happened at both Cynthia and Continental Parks. There is absolutely no excuse for either of these things to happen.

Replacing a soccer goal costs \$155.00. Replacing a regular swing costs \$80.00 and a baby swing costs \$105.00. If we have to spend money to replace these items we cannot afford to add new items; items that have been requested by residents.

If anyone sees any vandalism or theft on any of our community property please report it either to our office at 630-393-3033 or 911. Both vandalism and theft are crimes, and will be treated as such.

We are requesting that parents remind their children that these behaviors are not acceptable and to ask their children if they know anything about these incidents, or if they have seen who is responsible. If so please do not confront anyone yourself but relay the information to us, anonymously if you prefer. We'll take appropriate measures.

Also, please remember that while all are welcome at our playgrounds we do ask that children under the age of 12 be accompanied by an adult.
