CITY BRUSH PICK-UP FOR MAY

Free brush pick-up for this year will begin in April. Summerlakes falls within Zones 1* & 2*.

Zone 1 - First Monday of May *(North of Batavia Road)

Zone 2 - Second Monday of May *(South of Batavia Road)

Please keep in mind that although brush is required to be set out by 7:00 a.m. on the designated Monday, pickup may occur on a day later in that week.

Brush piles must comply with the following guidelines:

- One pile per address
- Pile cannot be greater than 3 feet in height, 8 feet in depth, and 15 feet in length
- Branches cannot be longer that 8 feet in length and no more than 8 inches in diameter
- Branches must be placed with the larger cut end toward the street

Brush piles that do not conform to these standards will not be picked up and a notice will be left on the front door. Call the City Public Works Department at 630.393.9050 for more information.

SUMMERLAKES HOMEOWNERS' BOARD MEETING APRIL 14, 2022

Meeting was called to order by President Steve Lewis at 7:00pm

Board Members Present: Steve Lewis; Harlan (Nick) Davis; Fred Baker; Jeanne Tassotto; Megan Kleiber; Mike Dobosiewicz. Absent: Pam Watts

Homeowners Present: Dave Alder; Jen Uriostegui; Kevin Siciak

<u>Homeowner Comments:</u> Dave Aldler raised questions about storage of trash cans. Jen Uriostegui raised questions about playgrounds; Kevin Siciak inquired about his Architecture project request.

Board Member Comments: None

Secretary Report: Minutes from the March meeting were submitted for approval. Harlan (Nick) Davis made a motion to approve as read, Fred Baker seconded. **Motion** carried.

<u>Financial Report:</u> The March financial report was submitted for approval. Mike Dobosiewicz moved to approve as read, Jeanne Tassotto seconded. **Motion** carried.

New Business:

- **-Security Breech**: Steve Lewis and Mickie Speedy reported that our Chase account had been hacked. The breech occurred through Chase, and Chase has assumed full responsibility to restore all funds. It has made more work for Mickie and her staff.
- **-Heating & Cooling:** Units have been inspected. All three of the cooling units on the roof need a deep coil cleaning estimated to cost at least \$1500. Mike Dobosiewicz made a motion to do this, spending up to \$2000. Fred Baker seconded. **Motion** carried.

An air conditioning unit in the party annex needs to be replaced, it was recommended to replace both since second unit will likely fail soon. It is more cost effective to replace both at once. Mike Dobosiewicz made a motion to replace both for up to \$10,000. Fred Baker seconded. **Motion** carried.

-Pool: Steve Lewis stated that he had been looking for pool architects and is waiting for replies.

Steve further reported that Just in Time had been able to locate and purchase the pump necessary to open the pool.

- **-Solar Panels:** Jeanne Tassotto and Steve Lewis both presented information about the feasibility of installing solar panels on the Clubhouse south roof. Advances in technology and changes in regulations make this project much more practical for our needs than in the past. It was decided to investigate this further after the pool project is further along.
- **-Playground:** Steve Lewis reported that seating and tables at playgrounds are being refurbished and that replacements swing seats have been ordered.

<u>Architecture Committee:</u> Steve Lewis reported that the planting required to close out completed sections of the lake project cannot be done until the water level goes down. The planting areas are already marked.

New benches are planned for Continental pond but, again it is currently too wet to do this or for the City to make the repairs they have agreed to do.

Motion to adjourn at 8:17 pm to Executive Session was made by Harlan Davis, seconded by Mike Dobosiewicz. Motion carried.
